This workshop will explore the implications of ethics to the everyday practice of social work. The workshop will review Illinois social worker licensure laws and rules and will discuss supervisor responsibilities. The presenter will offer practical suggestions for protecting social workers from disciplinary actions. The use of ethical practice to increase skills will also be emphasized. Other topics will include, strategies for selecting ethical supervisors, the role of documentation, and the implications of technology to ethics.
