ETHICS TRAINING REQUIRED BY ILLINOIS LICENSURE RULES

ETHICS TRAINING

All Licensed Social Workers (LSW/LCSW) are Mandated by Illinois Law to have 3.0 Hours of Approved Training in Ethics before renewing their license.
Don't risk your license. Sign-up to complete this requirement before the licensure renewal deadline of November 30, 2011.

From Illinois Department of Financial and Professional Regulation Rules

Section 1470.95 Continuing Education

a) Continuing Education Hours Requirements

1) Every licensee who applies for renewal of a license as a social worker or clinical social worker shall complete 30 hours of continuing education (CE) relevant to the practice of social work or clinical social work. At least 3 of the 30 hours must include content related to the ethical practice of social work.
